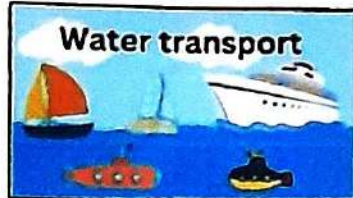
Modes of Transport-Land, Water and Air (Oral & Written)

Ans Loud sound from the speakers, vehicles horn and factories.

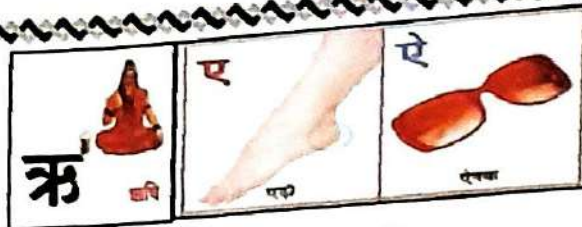
Q.5 How can we take care of the environment?

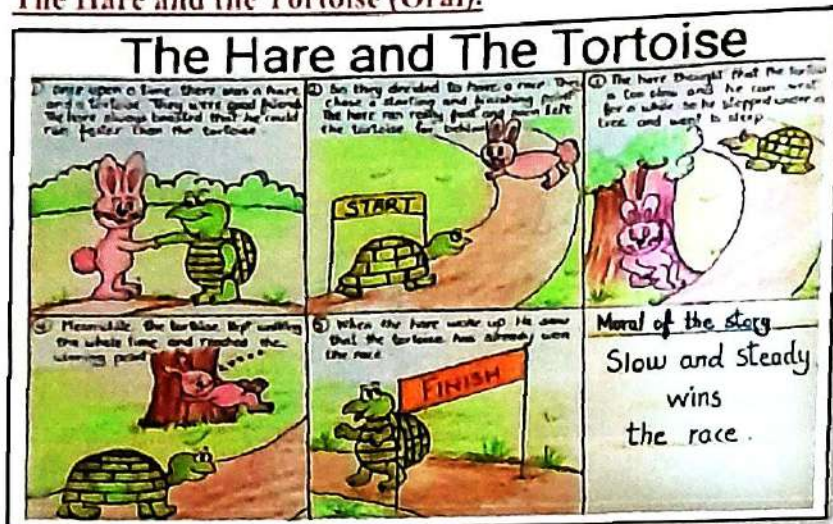

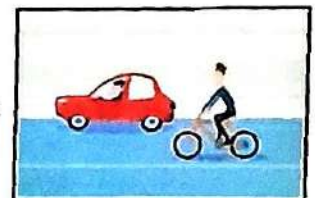


